

This year, the elementary students chose the book, <u>The Night Gardener</u> by Eric and Terry Fan as their winner. The real medal went to Javaka Steptoe's book, <u>Radiant Child</u>. The Mock Caldecott activity motivates kids to read and allows them to become critical thinkers about illustrations.



Kid's Club in January focused on creating open vs. fixed mindsets and encouraging acts of kindness in the elementary. Guidance counselor Mrs. Sherry Rizzuto creates the lessons for these mixed age groups, which meet twice a month.


In music, the students are doing creative movement as response to music by "Shadowing" with partners.








These third grade students are working with owl pellets in science and then enjoying ice cream they made during Ag in the Classroom.
